WHEREAS the Author of the Trust has endowed a sum of Rs.1,001/- (Rupees One thousand one only) for the purpose of creation of a Trust and such a sum has been transferred by him to the Trustees hereinafter mentioned and the Trustees also acknowledge the receipt thereof.

NOW THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH THAT:

1. A sum of Rs.1,001/- (Rupees One thousand one only) together with further accretions thereto and such other assets which may represent the said sum shall be held in Trust for the objects hereinafter set out.

2. The Trust shall bear the name **Swami Dayananda Educational Trust**.
3. The Trust shall be managed by the Board of Trustees consisting of not more than nine persons. A trustee to be appointed for this purpose shall be a person who is competent to contract and is eligible to be appointed as a Trustee under the provisions of the Indian Trust Act.
4. The Author of the Trust has declared herself to act as a Founder-Trustee and shall appoint the other Trustees. In pursuance of such powers, she hereby appoints the following gentleman as Trustee. Besides the Founder-Trustee, Swami Dayananda Saraswati, C/o. Correspondent, Swami Dayananda College of Arts and Science, Manjakkudi, Tiruvarur, 612 610 shall be the life time/Permanent Trustee.

Both these trustees shall have power to co-opt additional trustees.

5. On the vacation of the Office by any one or more of the Trustees by reasons of their own volition or death or otherwise, the remaining Trustee/Trustees shall co-opt additional Trustees.
6. The Office of the Trust shall be at **C/o. Correspondent, Swami Dayananda College of Arts and Science, Manjakkudi, Tiruvarur, 612 610, Tamil Nadu** or such other place or places as may be decided by the Trustees, from time to time.

7. The OBJECTS of the Trust shall be -

- (1) to foster ideals with an objective to provide high quality education - the best possible mental, physical and social education - to the children and youth
- (2) to promote, establish, maintain, run, develop and manage or take over and administer schools, colleges or other bodies or institutions of all descriptions, and to improve education and to aid, assist in the establishment, maintenance of schools of all types, colleges, industrial, technical, vocational and other arts, crafts, science schools, colleges and educational institutions, hostels, book banks and libraries for the benefit of the students and help educational institutions, whether general, technical, vocation, professional or of all description, whatsoever for the welfare and uplift of the general public.
- (3) to construct, establish, run and maintain educational institution or institutions and if thought fit, to start or take over other educational institutions and centres for training of men and women in technical, mechanical, scientific and similar pursuits.
- (4) to build, construct, establish, run, maintain, manage and/or afford financial help to any educational scientific institutions for imparting education in arts, science, vocation and technical subjects or for research in any or all of the above and for imparting education particularly in the study and research of sanskrit and vedantha for the spiritual benefit of mankind, of ancient philosophy, of ancient Indian culture and places of archaeological, historic or artistic importance in

order to create awareness and perpetuate the desire among the younger generation, especially architects in the works of ancient places of public interest, architecture, culture and heritage.

- (5) to encourage, study and institute scholarships, prizes, shields etc for students in any school, college or educational institutions or for students studying a particular subject or course or those undergoing training in particular field or those engaged in research in any field of creative activity in any part of India.
- (6) to prepare and encourage the preparation of suitable treatises and textbooks in literature, science and other technical subjects like engineering, law, accountancy, economics etc, as may be useful and decide upon by the trustees and help in their publications.
- (7) to publish and/or aid in the publication of books, journals and periodicals, which promote the fulfillment of the objects of the Trust such that it does not involve any activity resulting in profits.
- (8) to aid students, teachers and vidwans engaged in the study of Sanskrit, Indian philosophy by giving them stipends, books, fees and medical aid and running free hospitals and distribute food and clothing to students and to provide mid-day meals for students in schools or elsewhere.
- (9) to provide financial assistance to poor and indigent students pursuing courses of study in technical, professional and vocational and the like in schools, colleges, institutes,

polytechnics and also extend help in all forms like payment of tuition fees, hostel or mess fees, cost of text books, examination fees and all other expenses connected with pursuing the courses of study.

- (10) to establish institutions for self-help and to assist existing institutions to extend moral, physical, monetary and intellectual assistance to deserving students in education, employment, social welfare needs.
- (11) to provide industrial training by setting up vocational centres, mainly with the object of promoting of skilled artisans and for this purpose, to provide factory working atmosphere by accepting job work solely with the object of achieving the above objective and not for the purpose earning profit.
- (12) to build up centres to afford free education and training in arts, crafts and technical subjects to the economically poor and backward people and prepare them for earning their own livelihood.
- (13) to promote, establish, maintain, reading rooms and to provide books, magazines, periodicals and other literary and technical works for the benefit of the students and public.
- (14) to provide interest free loans to the needy and poor for educational purposes refundable in such instalments, as the trustees may determine, from time to time
- (15) to accept any gifts, donations, endowments or property or money on such terms and conditions, as may be imposed by

the donor or donors (but so as not to incur any liability on the part of the trustees) in furtherance of all or any of the objects of the trust

- (16) to build up the Corpus out of the amount donated or use the said donation for any other objects of the trust herein mentioned as trustee may deem fit'
- (17) to donate, contribute funds to any charitable institutions, having same objects as this trust thereby indirectly facilitating carrying out the objects of the trust
- (18) to relieve the poor and indigent men and women of all communities without any restriction as to caste, community or creed
 - (a) by constructing, establishing and maintaining schools, hospitals, poor homes providing free food, shelter and clothing for aged and for the infirm destitute.
 - (b) By running gymnasiums, orphanages, libraries, reading rooms, recreation clubs, halls and premises for the benefit of the poor in the course of promotion, institution and diffusion of science, literature and fine arts
 - (c) By providing medical assistance, and
 - (d) By providing financial assistance for marriage
- 19 to construct, establish, run, maintain, manage centres for the training of young men and women in technical, mechanical, scientific and similar pursuits.

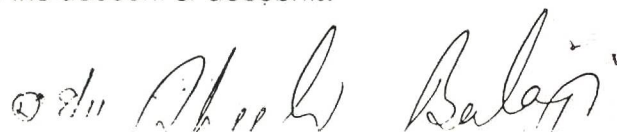

- 20 To afford medical relief to the sick and suffering irrespective of caste, community or creed by constructing and/or maintaining hospitals, dispensaries, maternity, children homes and hostels to feed the poor.

PROVIDED THE OBJECTS MENTIONED ABOVE SHALL NOT INCLUDE CARRYING ON ANY ACTIVITY FOR PROFIT IN INDIA AND SHALL NOT INCLUDE CARRYING ON ANY ACTIVITY OUTSIDE INDIA.

8. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES:

- (i) To purchase, sell, exchange, lease out, acquire, lease or otherwise take on rent for occupation any land, building or immovable property for running the office, schools or other educational institutions or hostels run by the Trust.
 - (ii) To co-operate with other institutions and associations having objects same as those of the Trust,
 - (iii) Generally, to do all acts and things and under all such works that are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects mentioned herein para "7" above.
9. The income of the Trust shall be applied only to charitable purposes in India or shall be accumulated for such purposes in India and the beneficiaries of the Trust shall not be restricted to any community, caste or creed but the Trust shall be for the benefit of the public generally.
10. The Trustees shall open one or more accounts with any one or more of the scheduled banks and any one or more of the Trustees authorised in this behalf shall operate the account or accounts.



11. All amounts received shall be deposited with the Bankers of the Trust regularly, after keeping sufficient amount to meet the day-to-day expenses.
12. The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant to be appointed by the Trustees and the accounts shall be closed as on 31st day of March every year and the first such accounts shall be closed on the 31st day of March, 2004.
13. The trustees shall maintain the minutes of the meeting of the board of trustees.
14. The net income arising out of the Trust properties whether movable or immovable after meeting all expenses shall be utilised for all or any of the aforesaid objects in India as the Trustees may decide from time to time.
15. The trustees shall be entitled to invest the donations received in any property whether movable or immovable and shall also buy, sell, exchange or lease out any property and also be entitled to deposit any amount in such a manner that it is in accordance with and not violative of the provisions of Section 11, 12 and 13 of the Income-Tax Act 1961 as may be amended from time to time.
16. The trustees shall have the power to waive the unpaid interest free loans provided as financial assistance.
17. The Trustees shall be entitled to appoint such staff for administering the Trust property on such terms as they may decide and shall have the power to dismiss the persons so appointed.

18. The Trustees shall not be entitled by way of profits, interest, dividend etc and shall be reimbursed in respect of actual expenditure incurred by them during the course of discharging their duties.
19. The Trustees may raise or borrow money required for the purpose of the said Trust on a mortgage or pledge of the Trust properties or any part thereof with or without any security and at such rate of interest and on such terms as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
20. The Trustees shall, from time to time, be entitled to frame, modify and amend the Rules for the purpose of administering the Trust in a smooth manner subject to obtaining prior approval from the income tax authorities.
21. The Trustees, in the event of dissolution of the trust, shall distribute the assets of the trust to other trusts, having all or any of the objects enumerated in sub-clauses (1) to (20) of clause 7 of the Trust deed.
22. The Author hereby confirms that the benefits of the trust shall enure to the public at large irrespective of caste, religion, community, sex etc.
23. The author hereby further confirms that prior approval of the Director of Income-tax (Exemptions) shall be obtained before alienation of any immovable property.
24. The activities of the trust would be of purely charitable nature not motivated for profit. The trustees shall ensure that any application of its income on religious purposes shall not exceed such percentages as may be prescribed from time to time under the Income-tax Act.
